2. Ribe Viking Centre

meet the real Vikings and get that authentic, living Viking experience at Ribe VikingCenter. In the heritage centre the everyday life of the Vikings is reenacted amongst authentic reconstructions of houses and buildings from Ribe in 710-980 AD

3. Guided tour of city of Ribe

explore the rich history and culture of the oldest city in Denmark. First mentioned in 862 AD, the charming city centre boasts cobbled streets and alleys around the Romanesque cathedral dating from 1122, the church and monastery of St. Catharinae founded in 1228 and many half-timbered houses dating from the 16th and 17th centuries.
